

## Saint Patrick's Day

- > Corned Beef & Cabbage + Beer
- > St Patrick = Roman British (died at 73 y.o.)
  - accused from taking expensive gifts from rich women
  - charged lots of \$ for baptisms
- > 8<sup>th</sup> century - 700 years later he = patron Saint of Ireland
  - to assimilate conquered lands w/o the need of occupying force
- > Why 37.5 million claim Irish ancestry?
- > Mid-1800's = huge influx of Irish into U.S.
  - due to potato famine
    - due to climate changes: from warm to freezing by 1400 (for 400 yrs)
- > Vikings find Great Banks w/ tons of cod
  - they use cod for trade
- > Warmer climates near Mediterranean = more food, kids, labor
  - 1000 - 1400 AD
- > 1400 AD + weather becomes colder, wetter, unpredictable
  - Northern + Central Europe can't grow warm weather crops
  - Lots of people, food shortages; wealthy/holy = fine
- > Adaptation - cold weather crops must be grown
  - Apples, Rye, Barley, Hops, cabbage, beets, potatoes, carrots
- > Preservation req.
  - Pickling, Fermentation, Salting, Root Cellars
  - Everything gets pickled
- > Cows not producing milk; thus, used to make corned beef (pickled beef)
- > Adaptation { and Pigs = easy to feed
- > Wheat bread → Rye Bread      - Pasta/Rice → Potatoes
- > Wine → Beer                      - Fish/chicken → Beef + Pork

- > Storage wet + cool
  - Grains would develop Ergot (mold)
  - After making bread, hallucinations occurred
    - St. Anthony's fire = hallucinations
    - 40-60K executed for being a "witch"
- > Diet = meat + potatoes (in Northern Europe)
- > Ireland = perfect climate for potatoes
- > *Prostista* destroys potato crops, causing hunger
  - 1 million died
  - 1.5 million immigrate to U.S.
    - They cluster in different parts of U.S.
    - Settling in as officers, silver miners, etc.
