- > Physical geography = diverse
 - mountains, oceans, deserts, forests, lakes
 - Highest & lowest points in continental U.S.
 - ° 14,506 to -282 feet (within 75 miles of each other)
 - Hottest & Coldest temps
- > Leading industrial state; 1st in almost every general manufacturing co.
 - 1st in agriculture
 - 1st in crop production
 - produces more than 350 crops
 - grows > 1/2 of nation's fruits & veggies & nuts
- > Plant Diversity
 - leads in #'s of native & endemic plant species
 - 32% (approx 1/3) of plants in the U.S.
 - recognized as a hotspot for plants
 - 220 plants = endangered
- > Animal diversity
 - 1/3 reptiles; 1/5 amphibians; 1/2 birds & mammals / U.S.
 - 157 endangered animals
- > Diversity due to
 - Geographical diversity
 - Abiotic Factors
 - ° Soil, water (when, how much, form), temp. (range, extremes)
