  - "providing care that is respectful of and responsive to individual patient preferences. needs, and values" and "ensuring that patient values guide all clinical decisions."



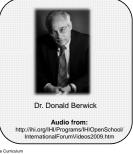
- · Why Important?
  - "When informed patients take an active role in managing their diabetes, and providers are prepared, proactive, and supported with time and resources, their interaction is likely to be productive."
  - "patient-centered interaction can lead to better diabetes care, more efficient and effective practices, healthier patients, and more satisfied patients and providers."

- Collaboration



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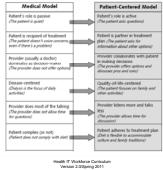
#### Rise of the Active Patient
