Mitosis

Prophase - DNA folded into chromosomes / envelope disappears

MetaPhase - Chromosomes line up in center

Anaphase - Pulls one copy of each away to one half of the cell

Fetaphase - Cut the cell in half / envelope reforms

How do cells know when to start and stop?

- Don't really know

2 ways cell division is controlled

Contact inhibition

when cells are not in contact they divide

* adds fibrinogen into wounds as a protective measure.

* Scars and Scar tissue

Cell Senescence

- Cells keep track of their divisions

- Timing their own death, and kill themselves when they are done - reached the set # of divisions

* Telomeres: Repeating caps at the end of DNA

every time the cell divides the telomere gets shorter and shorter

* Apoptosis = Cell Suicide..

Cancer: uncontrolled cell growth

Cancer cells are taking all nutrition from cells and tissues
