- Testicular Disorders
- Testicular Cancer
 - Risk factors
 - Age:mainly young men between 20-39 years
 - History of undescended testicle
 - · Family history of testicular cancer
 - Symptoms
 - Pain, swelling or lumps
 - Treated by surgery, radiation or chemotherapy
 - Complications of treatment: infertility
